

ORDINANCE 23-00469

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF MUSTANG RIDGE, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the annexation of territory, subject to the requirements therein and the laws of this state.

WHEREAS, the procedures prescribed by the laws of this state have been duly followed with respect to the following described territory, to wit:

Travis County


1. 5.89 Acres, Property ID #300867 located at 10001 US Hwy 183 S. Owned by PRESERVE PARTNERS OPPORTUNITY ZONE FUND LTD.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSTANG RIDGE, TEXAS:

That the heretofore described property is hereby annexed to the City of Mustang Ridge, Travis County, Texas, and that the boundary limits of the City of Mustang Ridge be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described territory within the city limits of the City of Mustang Ridge, and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said city, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all the rights and privileges of other citizens of the City of Mustang Ridge and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said city. Pursuant to agreement between the City of Mustang Ridge and the property owner, the above-described land is annexed into the city with an initial zoning classification of light industrial.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Travis County, Texas, a certified copy of this ordinance.
